RBI regulated entities and intermediaries including standalone primary dealers, CCIL, NPCI, payment system operators and financial market participants operating in RBI regulated markets 7. All Non Banking Financial Corporations 8. All micro finance institutions 9. Offices of advocates if operations of Courts, Tribunals or Commissions of Enquiries are on
